In late 2002-early 2002, two fundamental changes occurred. The secretarial job was split into two positions and a two year term limit was adopted for officers and board members. Names highlighted in light green would be termed out for that position in the shaded term, although the board has discretion to extend the term by a majority vote if there are difficulties filling the position. Single year terms used to offset some positions were not counted toward the term limits but previous service could be. In 2003, the club voted to eliminate the board position vacated when Dawn was elected president. This was done to make an even number of officers and board members (other than the president) so that the president would resume the role of tie-breaker for votes. In 2004, the President created a ByLaws & Constitution expert; also, one board member moved to an officer's position in mid-term and the board position was filled by appointment of the standing board.
